HERAKLION

Knossos Palace & Heraklion City - HER 02

Crete is the largest and the most rugged of the Greek islands. It is also the home of the great Minoan Civilization and the mythological home of Zeus. After a short drive through the town of Heraklion the tour will arrive at the Knossos excavations. Here, Sir Arthur Evans' archaeological discoveries revealed a civilization dating back to 4000 BC, when a great empire flourished on the island of Crete. Based on the wealth of artefacts that were found, Evans theorized that this was the site of the ancient Minoan Kingdom. These findings will be viewed in detail, as your guide will lead you on a journey of discovery to learn of the sophisticated culture that flourished thousands of years ago on this island. The Palace, decorated with frescoes and shields houses the Hall of the Royal Guard, the Hall of the Double Axes, the King's Chamber with the alabaster throne, the Queen's Apartment, beautiful courtyards and shrines. Having visited this remarkable site your coach will take you to the heart of Heraklion, where you will be given some free time to explore its beauties combining the facilities of a modern city with the unique Greek islands' ambience. You will then re-board your coach for the return journey to the Venetian lion-guarded port of Heraklion to rejoin your ship.

REMARKS - Walking in the archaeological site of Knossos will be on uneven gravel surfaces. Passengers may not be allowed to enter the site with large bags/rucksacks

A Taste of Crete - HER 04

The tour begins from the Venetian lion-guarded port of Heraklion with a drive through the city to the famous wine producing area of Peza, south of Heraklion. The drive is through breathtaking landscapes of countryside and vineyards as old as Minoan times on the way to the first stop, a modern winery, where you will see the updated methods of wine making and sample some of the delicious Cretan wines. The drive continues through rural villages to the village of Archanes, the municipality in the area. On the way a photo stop is made at Vathypetro to view one of the oldest farmhouses in Crete, dating to the Minoan period 16th century BC. The tour continues through the island's hilly countryside where olive groves and vineyards existed from as far back as 4000 years ago. Arriving at the village of Archanes, situated 10 km south of the Palace of Knossos, the quaint market town of Archanes has many restored sandstone houses dating from the Turkish period. At a local taverna in the villages' tree shaded square, you can sample an assortment of Cretan snacks and locally produced wine as well as a chance to mingle with many of the locals themselves. Some free time to browse before the return drive to the port of Heraklion and the ship.

ISTANBUL

Istanbul by Night - IST 01

Take part in the entertainment and night life at one of the finest nightclubs of the city. Depart by coach and take a short drive through the illuminated streets of Istanbul before arriving at the Kervansaray Night Club, a well-known Istanbul establishment. Enjoy a variety of Turkish specialties while you are entertained by Turkish musicians, belly dancers and folk dancers, performing dances from different regions of Turkey. At the end of the show, join in, as familiar favourite songs are sung. Re-board your coach and continue your sightseeing by night before returning to your ship.

Highlights of Istanbul / Lunch onboard - IST 02

Begin your excursion an orientation drive through the business centre of the modern city, across the Galata Bridge, along the banks of the Golden Horn and under the Byzantine Aqueduct of Valens. On the way, see the Süleymaniye Mosque, dedicated to Sultan Süleyman the Magnificent. You will continue around the mighty city walls, which once protected Constantinople from the many invasions and attacks it incurred over the centuries. In the Old City, your first visit will be to the Byzantine Hippodrome, which was once one of the largest chariot race grounds of the Byzantine Empire. Visit the Sultanahmet Mosque, where large groups of pilgrims commenced their pilgrimage to Mecca. It is decorated with 21,000 blue Iznik tiles naming it the Blue Mosque. Then, return to your ship for lunch on board. Afterwards, walk through the immense gardens to visit the magnificent Topkapi Palace, the official residence of the Ottoman Sultans. See the famous treasury section with Spoonmaker's Diamond, the 7th largest diamond in the world. Enter the kitchen buildings, today displaying the 3rd richest collection in the world of Chinese and Japanese porcelain.

Highlights of Istanbul with Lunch - IST 03

Begin your excursion an orientation drive through the business centre of the modern city, across the Galata Bridge, along the banks of the Golden Horn and under the Byzantine Aqueduct of Valens. Enter the kitchen buildings, today displaying the 3rd richest collection in the world of Chinese and Japanese porcelain.

Scenic Bosphorus Cruise - IST 04

Commence your tour with a short orientation drive through the modern city of Istanbul, crossing the Galata Bridge en-route to the Golden Horn. The impressive Süleymaniye Mosque, built by Turkish architect Sinan and dedicated to Sultan Süleyman the Magnificent, can be viewed en-route. At the Golden Horn, take a short walk to the Cruise Boat Station where your private boat will be waiting for your enchanted trip on the Bosphorus. You will sail past Dolmabahçe and Çırağan Palaces built on the European shore, glide under the

Bosphorus Bridge and past Beylerbeyi Palace, Anatolian Fortress and Kanlica on the Asian shore. You will have the chance to take great photographs cruising between these two continents.

Secret Treasures of Istanbul with lunch - IST 05

This tour is designed to give guests an insight on the best and famous monuments in Istanbul remaining from Byzantine Empire era. Depart from the pier for an interesting tour of Istanbul with a city orientation drive through the business centre of the modern city, across the Galata Bridge, along the banks of the Golden Horn and under the Byzantine Aqueduct of Valens. On the way, see the Suleymaniye Mosque dedicated to Sultan Suleyman the Magnificent, built by the famous Turkish Architect, Sinan. Arrive at Chora Museum. This 11th century church of St Saviour in Chora is the most important Byzantine monument in Istanbul after the St Sophia Museum. It displays a collection of 14th century frescoes, gold inlaid mosaics and some of the world's finest Byzantine paintings. Afterwards drive along the ancient Byzantine city walls to arrive at the Byzantine Hippodrome, where the chariot races and celebrations in honour of the emperors once took place during the Byzantine Empire era. Visit the ancient church of St Sergius and Bachus, which belonged to the monastery of Hormisdas and was built as the result of a vow sworn by Justinian when he was on the point of being executed for conspiring against his predecessor. The church is unique in shape as it is an irregular quadrilateral in which is inscribed an octagon formed by the pillars supporting the dome. The tour will continue with an Underground Cistern, consisting of a network of waterways built as far back as the 3rd century BC, to protect the city against long sieges. Continue to Balat area, another historical area of Istanbul for lunch at Fener Kosku, an old historical Greek building. After the lunch, you can visit The Patriarchate, which is located just 50 m away from your restaurant or you can relax walking along the Golden Horn. Then, drive to the Rustem Pasha Mosque, located in Eminonu close to Spice Market. This Mosque was built by Sinan in 1550 for Rustem Pasha, a grand vizier, who married one of the daughters of Suleyman the Magnificent. Inside and on the facade you see some beautiful Iznik faience. The mihrab completely covered with faience tiles and the mimbar are particularly striking.

KUSADASI

Ephesus & the House of Virgin Mary - KUS 01

Drive through the colourful town of Kusadasi to reach Mt Koressos. Situated in a small valley where the humble chapel lies on the site of the little house where The Virgin Mary is believed to have spent her last days. Despite the many controversies, the Christian World still favours this belief and the site has been officially sanctioned by the Vatican for pilgrimage. Continue on to Ancient Ephesus and walk through the Magnesian Gate, which is the entrance to the ancient city of Ephesus. Your guided walking tour will take you through one of the most magnificent excavations in the world. See the Odeon (concert hall), the Fountain of Trajan, the steam-heated Baths of Scolastika, the Temple of Hadrian and the Latrians, the Library of Celsus and The Great Theatre, the largest one in antiquity with a capacity of 24,000 seats where St Paul preached. Walk back to the coach along the Arcadian Way, where Mark Anthony and Cleopatra once rode in procession. While driving back to Kusadasi, just outside Ephesus, view the Basilica of St John, which was erected over his grave in the 6th century AD by Emperor Justinian. Before returning to the ship, enjoy free time in Kusadasi.

REMARKS - Tour not suitable for passengers with walking difficulties.

Ancient Ephesus - KUS 02

Drive through the colourful town of Kusadasi and along the coast to reach Ephesus, famous in antiquity for its Temple of Diana - one of the seven wonders of the ancient world - and later the home of St. John. During the years of the Roman Empire, the Greek port of Ephesus became the greatest city in Asia Minor. Upon arrival at Ephesus follow your guide and enter the ancient site through the Magnesian Gate. Discover innumerable monuments including the Forum, the Odeon, the Library of Celsus, the Thermal Baths of Scolastika and the Great Theatre, built in the Greek era and reconstructed in the Roman period, still noted for its remarkable acoustics. View the symbols all around and marvel at the fact that one is still able to read the inscriptions in the ancient Greek language. Walk back to your coach along the Arcadian Way, where once Mark Anthony and Cleopatra rode in procession. As you drive back to Kusadasi, on a hill above Selcuk, just outside Ephesus, view the Basilica of St John, which was erected over his grave in the 6th century AD by Emperor Justinian. Before returning to the ship, enjoy free time for shopping in Kusadasi.

REMARKS - Tour not suitable for passengers with walking difficulties.

MYKONOS

Mykonos by Night with Dinner & Show - MYK 02

Internationally famous for its hot, endless summer days and sultry sleepless party nights; where crowds dressed in the latest fashion or wearing as little as possible for comfort, gyrate rhythmically to the sounds of music spreading like a wave across the whitewashed narrow streets of town. Join a specially designed tour of Mykonos by night and experience an unforgettable evening ashore with dinner in a local taverna, full of colour and ambience as only Mykonos knows how to capture the visitor's expectations. The coach departs from Tourlos, the town's port, for a drive to a vantage point overlooking the city where a panoramic night view reveals the magic of Mykonos. Enjoy authentic native dishes and wine at a traditional Greek taverna. For your entertainment, a folkloric presentation will take place during dinner. Join in the revelry, partake in the dancing or simply clap your hands in rhythm to the music.

Delos Apollo Sanctuary - MYK 03

Delos, once a Sacred Island, is the legendary birthplace of the Sun God Apollo and his twin sister Artemis. For 500 years, tiny Delos was the religious and commercial hub of the entire Aegean. Today, the only remaining inhabitants are its treasured ruins and their caretakers. Depart from the port of Mykonos by boat, cruising along the western coast of Mykonos, through Diles and Rhenia Islands to the ancient harbour of Delos where you will begin your guided walking tour. You will first see the Agora and beyond it, the Sacred Way, which leads you to the Temple of Apollo. Next, view the remains of a Hellenistic Quarter with its harbour, water house, luxurious villas, such as the House of Cleopatra, the House of the Dolphins, the house of the Masks and the House of Dionysos, as well as remains of other notable quarters. Note the architecture and mosaic floors, which have survived over 2,500 years. Continue on and marvel at the spectacular Avenue of Lions, where five Naxian marble beasts from the 7th century BC crouch, vigilant guardians of the sacred lake, standing dry today. You will then re-board your boat for the return journey to Mykonos Town. Here you will have the chance to walk

along the cobblestone streets of this famous island with the numerous shops, cafes and restaurants before you take the available shuttle service for your return to the port to re-join your ship.

PATMOS

St John Monastery & Grotto - PAT 01

Depart from the port of Scala and enjoy a short drive to the village of Chora, where the monastery of St John is built within the walls of the strong fortification. As you walk uphill towards the entrance of the monastery marvel at this magnificent structure, which was built 900 years ago. View the courtyard, the monks' dining room and the old bakery before you visit the main church noted for its outstanding frescoes and interior decoration. Next, visit the small museum where priceless ecclesiastical treasures, books, manuscripts, mosaics, icons, splendid medieval textiles, vestments and jewellery are housed. Return to your coach and continue to the nearby Grotto of the Apocalypse and the Monastery of the Apocalypse above it. Walk down the steps to the Grotto of the Apocalypse. Here you will see the niches in the wall that mark the pillow and ledge used as a desk by the author of the Book of the Revelation and the crack in the rock made by the voice of God honouring the Holy Trinity. Afterwards, drive back to the port of Scala and enjoy some free time in this quaint and picturesque town.

REMARKS - Tour not suitable for passengers with walking difficulties.

Scenic Island Tour - PAT 02

An interesting scenic island tour has been designed for those passengers who prefer to discover the beauties of Patmos from the comfort of an air-conditioned coach. Start the tour from the port of Scala and drive to the central part of the island Chora, which is the location of the Majestic Byzantine Monastery of St John the Divine, built in 1088. Your sightseeing will first bring you to the Grotto of the Apocalypse and then to the windmills of Chora, once the landmark of all Aegean islands. Enjoy the view, take photos and continue your drive to visit the modern convent of Evangelismos (Annunciation) in the southern part of the island, where nuns follow the old traditions. Afterwards, continue around the island to see its landscapes of outstanding natural beauty comprising of rocky hills, dozens of tracts of land reaching out into the sea, tranquil beaches and many picturesque inlets. Before arriving at the port, a stop of 10 minutes is made at the square in Kambos in the northern part of the island. The tour ends at the port of Scala to enjoy free time in the quaint and picturesque little town.

PIRAEUS (only for In Transit passengers)

Athens & the Acropolis - PIR 01

The tour is an introduction to the splendour of the Golden Age of Athens as well as the modern city. The port of Piraeus itself is one of the finest examples of city planning in antiquity. On arrival in Athens you will visit the Acropolis on which is the Parthenon, the symbol of classical architecture. The entrance at the top of the hill is through the Propylea, the gates through which the Panathinaea processions entered, built totally of white marble and covering an area of 50 m across the whole western front of the Acropolis. Next to these is the Temple of Athena Niki also known as Wingless Victory. The Parthenon is the major temple built in honour of the Goddess Athena. Her statue decorated the centre of the temple and was made of ivory and gold. Next to the Parthenon is the smaller Temple of Erechthion with lovely sculptured young maidens supporting the roof of the porch. From the top of the Acropolis you can also admire the ancient theatre of Herodus Atticus with its remarkable acoustics. Performances are still held each summer, the highlights of cultural events in the Eastern Mediterranean. Leaving the Acropolis, the tour takes you by the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, guarded by the Evzones dressed in their traditional costume, Parliament, the Presidential Palace and the Panathinaikon Stadium, where the first Olympics of modern times were held in 1896. The entire stadium is built of pure white marble. Then drive by the Library - Academy - University three building representing 19th century architecture that blend with the classical influence. The tour will then pass Omonia Square, the commercial centre of the city and Syntagma Square, which is the business, and cultural centre. There will be time during the tour to browse and do a little shopping in stores located at the base of the Acropolis.

Cape Sounion - PIR 02

Depart from Athens in the direction of Sounion following the coastal road known as the Apollo Coast, passing by the fashionable seaside suburbs of Glyfada, Voula and Vouliagmeni by way of the summer resorts of Varkiza, Lagonissi and Saronis to arrive at Cape Sounion. At the top of the promontory, the Temple of Poseidon, God of the mighty oceans stands proudly. The temple built in the austere Doric style and is in memory of King Aegeas, who died falling off the cliff. Lord Byron chose this very temple to carve his name on one of the columns in the 19th century and which still can be observed today. After the guided visit of the site you will have some free time to browse and relax near the site. From here the tour will head towards Piraeus taking the inland route first and then the coastal road.

Athens & the picturesque Plaka - PIR 03

Leaving the port of Piraeus, one of the finest examples of city planning in antiquity, your coach will take via the coastal road leading to the city that hosted the 2004 Olympic Games. On arriving in Athens, you will start your city orientation driving past the Temple of Zeus, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, guarded by the Evzones dressed in their traditional costume, Parliament, the Presidential Palace and the Panathinaikon Stadium, where the first Olympics of modern times were held in 1896. The whole stadium is built of pure white marble. You will then drive by the Library - Academy - University three building representing 19th century architecture that blend with the classical influence. The tour will then pass by Omonia Square, the commercial centre of the city and Syntagma Square, which is the business and cultural centre. Your Athens' city orientation will end at a leading cafe at the base of the Acropolis from where you will be able to view all the majestic monuments of the amazing Acropolis and its pride, the Parthenon while enjoying your refreshment. You will then enter the old part of the city called the Plaka and explore its predominately pedestrian streets with the picturesque houses, shops and numerous cafes. After your free time in Plaka you will re-board your coach for the return journey to Piraeus port.

Excursion to Delphi - lunch boxes - PIR 04

This tour will take a scenic ride into the Greek countryside, northwest and for an approximate driving time of 3 hours from Piraeus to Delphi. Your first short stop for the day will be for facilities and refreshment (at own expense) at Livadia Friendly Stop. Then continue on to Delphi via Arachova, a picturesque mountain village before arriving at the legendary Castalian Spring, where your guide will tell you some of the myths that made the Navel of the World for ancient Greeks so unique. From Castalian Spring walk a short distance to the archaeological site of Delphi, where you will take the Sacred Way up to the Temple of Apollo. Follow your guide uphill and note the

various treasuries, small temples erected by the Greek city states, in order to receive the offerings made by their citizens. Marvel at the inscriptions from over 2,000 years ago that can still be seen today. Continue your walk and pass the sparse ruins of the Senate of the Delphi Oracle, which according to legend was guarded by the snake Python. Following the visit of the Delphi archaeological site is the Delphi Museum visit where your guide will brief you on some of the most important exhibits such as: Cleobis and Biton. Archaic statues, Chryselephantine statues, the frieze from the Treasury of the Siphnians, Metopes from the Treasury of the Athenians, White-ground kylix, The Charioteer, Marble statue of Aghias, Bronze incense-burner, the Column of the Dancers and the Statue of Antinoos. After the consumption of lunch boxes, returning to Piraeus with a short stop at Arachova village where some free time for souvenir and handicraft shopping will be made available.

RHODES

Rhodes & Lindos Combined - RHO 01

Drive along the picturesque south-eastern coastline, dotted with whitewashed villages, to Lindos, one of the most important of the three great cities of ancient times. See how this entire city is guarded by medieval walls which were constructed by the knights of St John in the 13th century. Within them stands the ancient Acropolis of Lindos on the brink of a precipice 400 feet above the sea. From the Acropolis, marvel at the breathtaking views covering the great expanse of the Aegean Sea and St Paul's Bay, where the apostle cast anchor during his historic voyage to Ephesus. Proceed on foot uphill, to the great staircase leading from the Hellenistic Portico to the Acropolis and Temple of Athena. Should you wish to make your way up by mule, a fee must be paid to the local muleteer. After the guided tour of the Acropolis, enjoy some free time on your own in Lindos village before meeting up with your coach. Return to Rhodes city and enjoy a panoramic drive through the new part of the city before continuing to Mount Smith to see the ruins of ancient Rhodes, the Temple of Apollo and the Diagoras Stadium. Afterwards your coach will drop you off at Porte d'Amboise, the start of the walking tour through the medieval city of Rhodes. Follow your guide through the northern part where the knights and their attendants once lived. View the Palace of the Knights and continue your walk down Chevaliers Road to meet up with your coach at the Marine Gate and return back to the ship.

Old City & Philerimos - RHO 02

Drive along the medieval walls to the summit of Mount Smith, the Acropolis of ancient Rhodes. From the tumbled massive pillars of the Temple of Athena, the view encompasses the nearby Temple of Apollo, the stadium of Diagoras and the port, once protected by the Colossus of Rhodes, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. The drive continues across the island to Philerimos. The summit of Philerimos was the site of Ialysos, one of the three ancient cities of Rhodes. Later sites include the restored Byzantine church of our Lady of Philerimos, a chapel with 15th century frescoes, and the ruined Castle of the Knights. After the visit and some free time, return to Rhodes and begin a guided walk of the old walled city to the Porte d'Amboise. It is a pleasure to stroll the street of the Knights with its medieval buildings, winding alleys, towers, turrets and emblazoned facades. You will then visit the impressive Grand Master's Palace and have the chance to see the superb mosaics. The pleasant walk passes through the Marine Gate to meet up with your coach and return to the ship.

Lindos with Lunch by the Beach - RHO 03

Enjoy a relaxing drive along the south-eastern coastline on the way to Lindos. On arrival, follow your guide and proceed on foot uphill to explore the Acropolis of Lindos, which overlooks the Aegean Sea and St Paul's bay and marvel at the breathtaking views. Afterwards there is free time to discover this lovely town at your own pace before meeting up again with your guide. Continue to Hotel Blue Sea, a modern luxury hotel, where you will be able to swim either in the crystal clear waters of the sea in front of the hotel or in the swimming pool. A buffet lunch with a variety of traditional Greek dishes is served in the hotel. You can use the hotel's changing facilities and sun beds. Return to Rhodes and drive beside the walls of the medieval city, stopping at Port d'Amboise, where you will start your stroll through the old town. Walk down Chevaliers Road to view the Palace of the Knights and the medieval houses of the knights. Continue passing by the hospital of the Knights of St John, before meeting up with your coach at the Marine Gate to return back to the ship.

REMARKS - Clients will have to bring their own beach towel.

SANTORINI

Thira & Oia Village - SAN 01

Driving along the road you will have the unique opportunity to admire the panoramic view of the Aegean Sea and the neighbouring islands. A unique sight is the various layers of lava that can be seen on the rock face, each layer being another phase of the activity of the volcano. Built on the Caldera rim, Oia Village is an excellent example of Cycladic architecture. Accompanied by your guide, explore the village walking along the cobblestone streets and the whitewashed houses with blue shutters, where one gets the impression that they are within a beautiful travel poster. The tour will then proceed to the town of Thira, an attractive town perched on the Caldera rim. Here, you will have time to stroll along the lanes of the little town or relax over a coffee as you gaze down upon Kamenes, the two black volcanic islets in the Caldera bay. A short cable car ride will take you down to the pier to rejoin the ship.

Santorini Sailing & Volcano - SAN 02

Enjoy a cruise around the active crater of Nea Kameni islet. Sail along the strange formations of its volcanic shores, where black lava rocks and white pumice are combined beautifully with the red colour of the lava. Take a walk to the top of the volcanic island where sulphur is spewed into the air from one of the craters. Enjoy this surreal landscape as your guide narrates the creation and history of the volcano and the last eruption leading to the destruction of the island of Santorini. The tidal wave created by the eruption was of such an immense magnitude, it destroyed the thriving city of Knossos on the island of Crete. As your caique enters the narrows of the two lava islets, Palea and Nea Kameni, the colour of the water changes from dark blue to sulphur green. In the distance, admire the breathtaking sight of Thira Town with its white washed houses clinging precariously on the rim of the Caldera. Take time to swim in the warm waters heated by Hot Springs on the sea floor.

REMARKS - It is recommended to bring your swimsuit and a towel
